Tool Box Talk No.31 Noise



- 1. Wear ear protectors at all times if exposed to a noise hazard.
- 2. Do not use cotton wool for ear protection; it is not effective.
- 3. Ear defenders must be a good fit to the head, in serviceable condition and worn the correct way around.
- 4. Make sure that ear plugs are a good fit in each ear and are correctly inserted.
- 5. Regularly cleanse re-usable earplugs to the manufacturer's instructions.
- 6. Use disposable earplugs once only.
- 7. Hands should be clean when handling all types of earplugs.
- 8. DO NOT alter the pressure of ear defenders by bending the headband.
- 9. If you have difficulty in wearing any type of hearing protector provided, report it.
- 10. There is no satisfactory treatment for noise induced hearing loss.
- 11. When working in a noisy work site in a Red Zone, a touch lookout must be employed.
